



Brescia Community Leader Award

Purpose: Brescia University College recognizes the contribution that students make in their schools and to their communities through their involvement outside the classroom. The many different kinds of service and participation in which students engage not only provides them with valuable learning experiences, but also allows students, as individuals, to make real contributions to society.

The Award: The Brescia Community Leader Award has a value of **\$1,000**. Four awards will be made each year to the top four entering students with the strongest applications. Applicants are asked to provide information about extracurricular involvement in their schools, and work or volunteer positions they have held in the community. Applicants will submit a brief essay explaining how they have contributed to their community, and what leadership skills they have learned from their activities. A student may hold the Community Leader Award in conjunction with an entrance scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must have a minimum 75% admission average
- Applications for the Community Leader Award must be submitted by May 30, 2010 and the award will be announced in June
- The award is contingent upon the student maintaining a 75% average on final grades, and registration at Brescia University College in the following September
