Responsibilities

This is a 0.5 credit course taught during the summer evening 2023 academic term. The Contract Faculty member must be available during the final exam period (July 31 – August 2, 2023).

The Contract Faculty member will be responsible for all aspects of teaching and administering the class, including preparing classes; preparing and administering tests/exams/assignments; and evaluating and submitting final grades. This may include responsibilities preceding or following the academic year in matters such as the preparation and administration of course syllabi, academic appeals and alleged scholastic offences. Required Qualifications:

Magisterial degree related to Organizational Behaviour, (MBA, MSc, MA Psychology) with demonstrated professional experience related to human resources/organizational behaviour or Ph.D./DBA (completed or in progress) in Organizational Behaviour, Organizational Development, Organizational Theory, or related discipline. Experience teaching international students preferred.
