**Late Fees**

**Full-Time Undergraduates - \$163.00**

Ancillary fees are mandatory and will be billed to your account.

**USC HEALTH, DENTAL and VIRTUAL DOCTOR PLAN FEES** - These fees will be billed to any student taking a total course load of 3.5 or higher. Students must pay for these fees but can then opt out of them. To opt-out of USC Health, Dental and Virtual Doctor Plans go to [www.mystudentplan.ca/purplecare/en/home](http://www.mystudentplan.ca/purplecare/en/home); students must opt out of the plan(s) by September 23, 2023 in order to obtain a refund (which will be reflected on your Statement of Account by mid-October and be applied against fees owing, if any).

**PAYMENT OPTIONS** - Students can pay their fees online as a bill payment through their online personal banking (**pay Brescia University College not Western University**) and use your student number as the account number. We also accept cheque, bank draft and debit card. Students should contact Deb Van Belois in the Business Office at extension 28308 or by email to [business@uwo.ca](mailto:business@uwo.ca) to discuss any fee issues prior to the first instalment due date of August 13, 2023. Second instalment of fees is due December 1, 2023. **Third party sponsored students must request that their sponsor submit a sponsorship letter to Brescia (Attn: Deb Van Belois) prior to the due date of the 1st instalment guaranteeing the payment of tuition for the academic year. It is the student's responsibility to ensure the fees are paid by the due date.**

**BURSARIES** - Bursaries are non-repayable financial awards made on the basis of financial need. Awarded bursaries are applied directly to the student's account. Students are also eligible to apply as needed during the course of the academic year. The application for General Bursaries can be found on Brescia's website. Bursary enquiries should be directed to Brescia Financial Aid at extension 28382 or by email to [brfinaid@uwo.ca](mailto:brfinaid@uwo.ca).

**OSAP** - Students should apply online at <https://osap.gov.on.ca>. Students are encouraged to apply by June 30th, annually. This ensures ample time to process documentation and ensure funding is in place for the start of the school year. OSAP enquiries should be directed to the Financial Aid Officer at extension 28382 or emailed to [brfinaid@uwo.ca](mailto:brfinaid@uwo.ca). OSAP students will be able to see their **anticipated** OSAP assistance applied to their net bill, and the payment of any remaining balance will be required by the instalment deadline (Term 1: Aug 13/23; Term 2: Dec 1/23). Before making any course changes, OSAP students are strongly recommended to visit The Hive at Brescia and speak with a representative to determine the financial implications, if any.
